



Current situation: Telehealth data overview



- Between March 2020 and December 2021, 90 million services to more than 16 million patients by 89,000 providers
- COVID-19 telehealth items are currently around 10% of MBS claims, but higher for some services
- Telephone accounts for 88% of telehealth
- Telehealth is skewed towards cities (as has been the overall increase in services)
- The most common telehealth services are short GP attendances


TOTAL TELEHEALTH SERVICES BY PROVIDER GROUP (%)

Recap MYEFO 2021-22 (1 Jan 22 changes)

- Permanent GP items are largely retained based on July 2021 updates
- Allied health, midwifery and nurse COVID-19 MBS telehealth items have transitions to permanent arrangements
- PreCOVID telehealth items have been deleted:
 - Patient-end support services provided by GPs, participating midwives and nurse practitioners
 - Mental health and eating disorder services by allied health providers
- Telehealth is included in proscribed pattern of practice for doctors
 - Deferred to 1 July 2022
 - Additional '30/20' rule for telephone services
 - Only applicable for GPs, Other Medical Practitioners and Consultant physicians




